

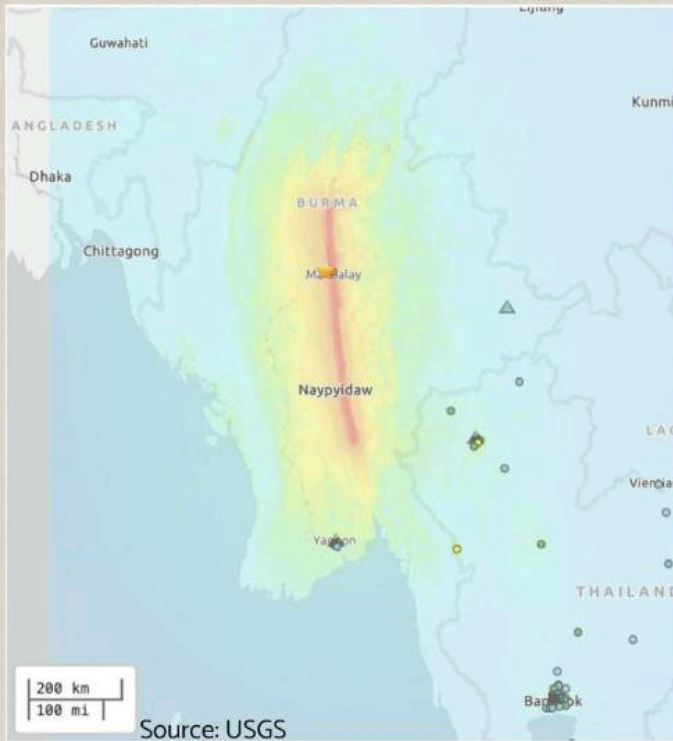


Situation Report (2) on the Impacts of A Very Severe Earthquake in Sagaing

March 30, 2025

SUMMARY

The death tolls continue to rise within 48 hours after the severe Sagaing earthquake. Aftershocks have also occurred in Mandalay, Nay Pyi Taw, and Bago, and another earthquake of magnitude 5.1 near Nay Pyi Taw at noon yesterday, a 4.2 magnitude earthquake near Shwebo in the morning and 5.1 earthquake near Sagaing this afternoon. Rescue operations are being delayed because of a lack of manpower and equipments, and also, the chances of survival rate for the missing people are very rare. Furthermore, there are many challenges in providing medical treatment to the injured people, and, as of now, only international Search and Rescue (SAR) teams have arrived. Not only SAR teams but also Emergency Medical Teams (EMT) from the neighboring countries are urgently needed. In urban areas, there are difficulties in management of the dead bodies by the earthquake. Widespread power outages are main causes of water shortages, and internet disruptions by SAC are limiting to access information. People whose homes have been destroyed are now temporarily staying in monasteries and other informal shelters, and there is an urgent need to provide instant food, drinking water, temporary shelter, and personal items to those affected.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE INTERVENTIONS

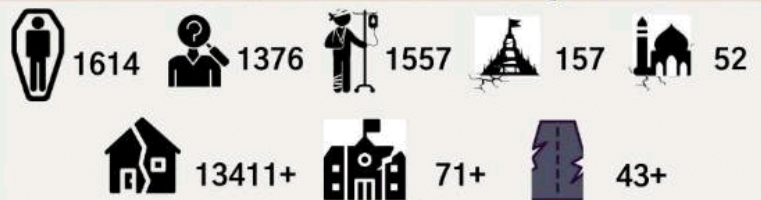
In the military-controlled cities, civil society organizations and philanthropic organizations are working with the personal contacts in the impacted areas but there is no proper and formal coordination amongst the response organizations. Yesterday, the National Unity Government announced that, if SAC guarantees safety and security of the CDM (Civil Disobedience Movement) civil servants, they could join the ongoing emergency rescue operations at the earthquake-hit areas. In the areas controlled by the revolutionary forces, rescue operations, medical treatment, and emergency responses are being carried out in coordination with local administrative, defense, and security organizations, as well as civil society groups, although there are challenges in communication and access to electricity. On the other hand, the military regime continues to carry out airstrikes on civilian assets. Humanitarian assistance to those areas is being provided in close coordination with both local and international organizations.

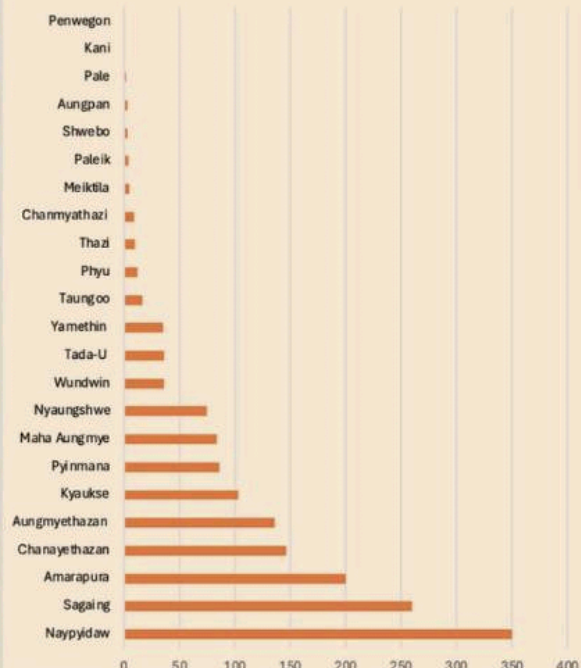
CHALLENGES

- Lack of electricity leading to shortages of water supply
- Due to the closure of stores, hospitals and clinics, challenges occur to access food, medicines and treatments
- Low profile emergency relief and response due to the fear of the military and its security forces for being arrested
- Critical need of skillful experts and equipments to remove collapsed and submerged buildings
- Urgent need of a large number of rescue personnel at Sintgaing, Paleik, Tada-U, Kyaukse, Myittha, Yamethin, Sagaing and Madaya townships
- Earthquake-hit communities in face of hardships to ask for assistance and seek emergency response support due to the Internet restrictions with VPN
- Very limited access to timely and accurate information
- Even in the catastrophic disaster, continuous forced conscription of the military resulting in the limited participation and support of the youths
